

The Memorandum of Understanding between Institute of Energy Saving and Energy Management, NTUU “KPI” and Chair in maritime business and logistics, University of Bremen was signed

The Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) on the department level was signed in late May during the visiting University of Bremen representatives – Professor Hans-Dietrich Haasis and Doctor Irina Dovbischuk, to the NTUU “KPI”.



Institute of Energy Saving and Energy Management, NTUU “KPI” and Chair in Maritime Business and Logistics, University of Bremen cooperate under the project “EnergyWare - Energy Efficiency in Warehousing along Maritime Supply Chains”, supported by the International Cooperation Network for Countries from the Eastern Partnership IncoNet EaP.

The main purpose of signing the MoU is confirmation of the intentions to increase cooperation in research and educational areas. In particular, institutions are interested in elaboration of the mutual scientific publications; conduction of conferences; exchange of researchers, scientists and students; implementation of international projects.

Head of the Chair in Maritime Business and Logistics, University of Bremen, Professor Hans-Dietrich Haasis and vice-rector for international cooperation of NTUU “KPI” Professor Sergii Sydorenko have expressed their confidence that signing the MoU will become the next step in the development of the Ukrainian-German cooperation.
